

Fourth World Day Against Abortion

Monday, 8 September 2025

Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary



We are pleased to announce the Fourth World Day Against Abortion. While we are pleased that the initiative has been welcomed in various parts of the world, we are only at the beginning. We cannot yet claim victory, not until the last child is saved from being sacrificed in the womb.

Victim of revolutionary ideologies, the world is heading towards the precipice of elevating abortion to a universally recognized 'right'. France holds the bloody record of including the 'right' to abortion in its Constitution; the United Kingdom is moving towards the complete decriminalization of abortion; and the situation in the rest of the world – with rare exceptions – is equally dramatic from the point of view of positive law.

Abortion is not just the loss of human life; it is much more. From a spiritual point of view, children sacrificed in their mother's womb cannot receive the sanctifying grace of Baptism. For those who are baptized and guilty of this crime, whether through direct or indirect participation, the consequence is excommunication 'latae sententiae', with repercussions not only on a personal level, but also on the entire Mystical Body of Christ.

Nor can we overlook the consequences for critical thinking among future generations. Those who are miseducated to not recognize human life as a human person from the moment of conception are taught to deny the most basic evidence and become unable to recognize what is true, beautiful and just. In this sense, a great work of recovery must be promoted.

The battlefield is therefore not merely ethical, philosophical or biological, but above all spiritual.

Catholics have the greatest treasure to offer in this battle: the sacrifice of the Holy Mass, the greatest of the Sacraments, celebrated in opposition to the 'sacrament of Satan' (abortion).

For these reasons, we propose the

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that will be organized as follows:

1. Celebration of Holy Masses against abortion, so that the offering of the Body and Blood of Our Lord may put an end to the daily slaughter of the innocent.
2. Eucharistic Adoration, accompanied by the recitation of the Holy Rosary, to invoke the help of the Mother of God, so that no more innocent lives are sacrificed to the Moloch of totalitarian relativism.
3. Processions of reparation for all sins against unborn life.
4. The faithful will recite the Holy Rosary with the same intentions.
5. Offering one or more days of fasting.
6. Conferences, both in person and remotely, to raise awareness of the horror of this crime.
7. Creation of a worldwide prayer network for the abolition of abortion.

Points 1, 2, 3 and 4 can be carried out either publicly or privately. The first point is certainly the most effective, because it involves offering the Second Person of the Holy Trinity to the Divine Majesty in order to implore an end to abortion. To this end, the faithful who have Holy Masses celebrated should inform the priest of the offerer's intention.

We trust in the collaboration of the clergy and Catholic associations to ensure that the Church's united prayer may obtain this grace from Our Lord.

The Fourth World Day Against Abortion will be celebrated on Monday, 8 September 2025, the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God and of all mothers.

In Italy, the day will be publicly celebrated on Saturday 6 September.
